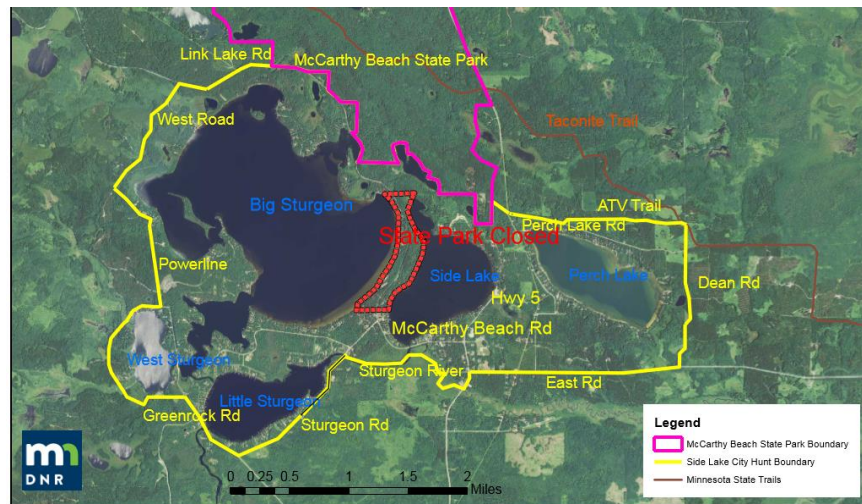

Deer are drawn to this area due to several factors and are reproducing at levels that are above normal due in large part to deer feeding. The population must be managed or we will continue with multiple vehicle collisions, the herd will become increasingly more dependent on feeding, or worse, the spread of Chronic Wasting Disease
