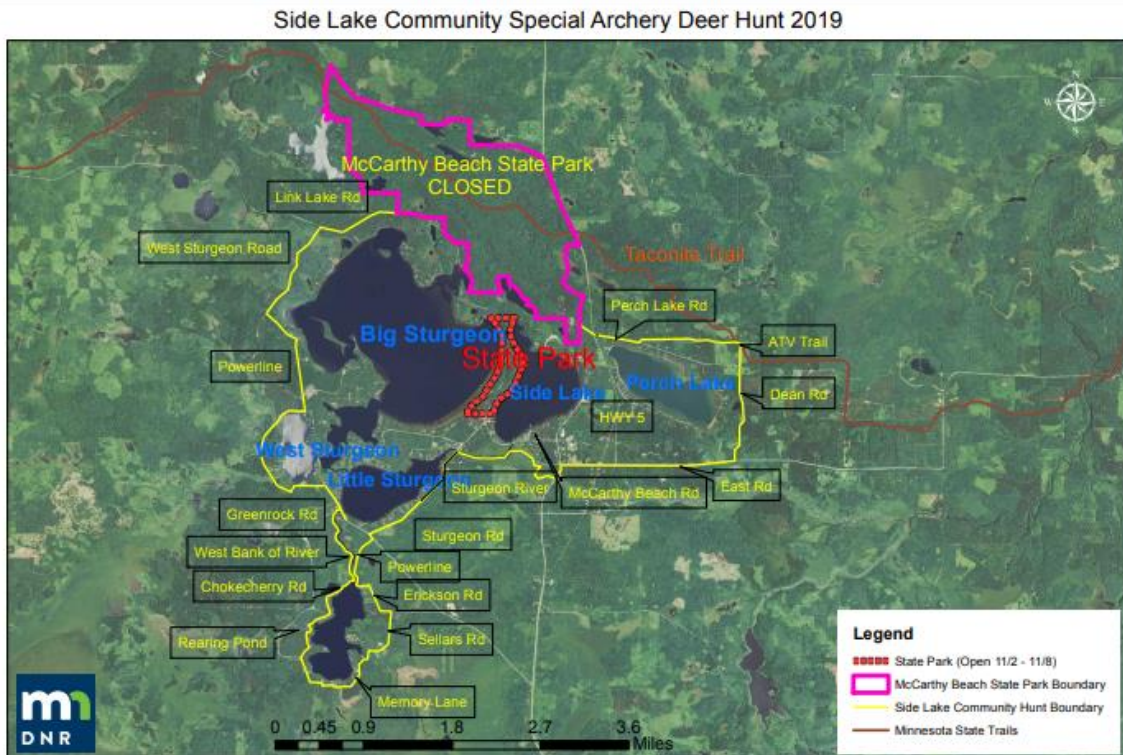

The Side Lake Community and State Park Archery Hunts are combined. You are authorized to archery hunt in both areas specified on this map. The hunt dates for the State Park sub-unit that is within the Side Lake Hunt Boundary are Saturday November 2 to Friday November 8, 2019. The State Park is closed to archery hunting except for these dates and for this area of the Park.

The deer population in the Side Lake Community has increased over the past few years and has reached a population density that is not naturally sustainable. Deer are drawn to this area due to several factors and are reproducing at levels that are above normal due in large part to deer feeding. The population must be managed or we will continue with multiple vehicle collisions, the herd will become increasingly more dependent on feeding, or worse, the spread of Chronic Wasting Disease. This is the second year of this Special Hunt.
