Rec Program Rules:

- No child will be allowed in the rec program without a signed permission slip from their parent or guardian and the <u>registration fee must be paid prior to attending.</u>
- Children are not allowed to leave the rec premises during rec hours without permission from their parent or guardian in either verbal or written form to the rec employees.
- Children are required to behave respectfully towards staff and other children. Bullying, teasing, etc. will not be allowed and the child may be expelled from the program, with no refunds.
- Improper language will not be allowed.
- Use of tobacco, alcohol and/or drugs will not be allowed. We have a zero tolerance policy. Use of any of the aforementioned items will result in the child being expelled from the program.
- Parents will be contacted if there are any disciplinary problems. If the problems continue, the child may be expelled from the program, with no refunds.
- Parents/Guardians will be expected to sign their child in and out each day for the program. If you child brings a bike to the rec program, it must stay in the bike rack until rec is over. As always, suggestions, or written comments are very much appreciated!
